



Overview

BSB41407 Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety reflects the role of individuals who use well-developed skills and a broad knowledge base in a wide variety of contexts. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. They may provide leadership and guidance to others with some limited responsibility for the output of others. This qualification would suit an OHS advisor in a full-time dedicated role.

Example roles in the industry are:

- Occupational Health and Safety Coordinator
- Occupational Health and Safety Officer
- Health and Safety Representative
- Health and Safety Committee Member
- Health and Safety Assistant
